The Vision of Lansdowne Church

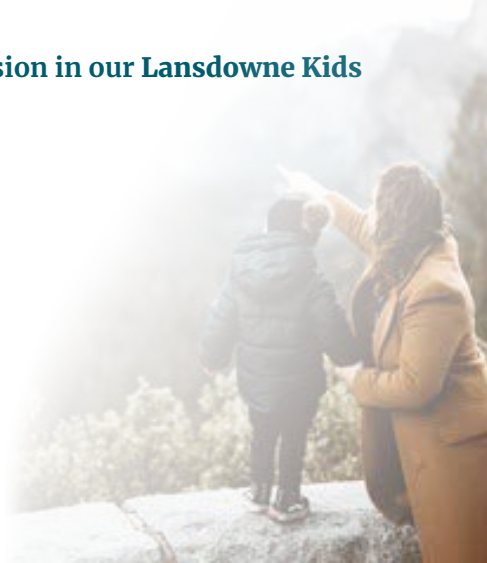
Glorify God | Proclaim Jesus | By the Spirit | Through the Word

1. Word – The Bible is the foundation of all that we do. Our curriculum, planning, teaching and routines. We inspire children to have a love for the Word and to grow in their knowledge of the Bible.

2. Worship – We provide opportunities for worship and living a life of worship to God – glorifying Him.

3. Discipleship – Our teaching is Gospel-centred and relevant to the child's age/stage of development. We disciple the children as individuals.

4. Relationship – We provide opportunities for children to develop their relationship with God. For example, through prayer, worship and the Word.

5. Mission – We inspire children to share their faith with others and we teach them about world mission.

6. Serving – We equip children for serving God by recognising individual gifting and encouraging children to use their gifts to serve God. We celebrate each child's uniqueness.

7. Love – We provide opportunities to grow in love for God and love for others. Love underpins our expectations of the children.

Across all of our Lansdowne Kids groups our planning, routines and events are underpinned by these values.
